MANAGE PATIENT POPULATIONS

Success under VBC will require technology and tools that help you reduce hospitalizations and unnecessary ED visits. Check for these capabilities:

- Stratify high-risk patients, recommend proper interventions and track patient health
- Identify in real-time who is at most risk for readmission or an adverse event
